GRAND OPENING OF THE NEW FRENCH VALLEY LIBRARY

FRENCH VALLEY, CA (July 29, 2021) – The Riverside County Library System is excited to announce the grand opening of the new French Valley Library, located at 31526 Skyview Road in French Valley. The public is invited to attend the grand opening ceremony on Saturday, July 31, 2021 at 10:00 AM.

"The French Valley Library is the most anticipated new facility in all of the Third District. The value that libraries bring to communities can't be overstated! All the while, we have done this without asking taxpayers to reach into their pockets," said Chuck Washington, Riverside County 3rd District Supervisor.

The new French Valley Library is a modern, aviation themed, 25,000 square foot single story library that includes amenities that are in high demand for the community. These amenities include private study rooms, community meeting room, opportunity rooms, furniture with plug in technology, public computers, teen library space, children's library space, and a children's story time room. The new library includes over 52,000 materials in the collection.

The outdoor grand opening event will be free to attend, and indoor family-friendly activities will follow the ceremony until 2:00 PM. Due to updated California Department of Public Health guidelines regarding face coverings, masks are recommended to be worn indoors regardless of vaccination status and will be available to patrons, if requested. The ceremony will include remarks by the Riverside County 3rd District Supervisor, Chuck Washington, Director of Riverside County Office of Economic Development, Suzanne Holland, and Riverside County Library System County Librarian, Barbara Howison.
